Seth's Playground Vision:

- Alissa Olsen came in to discuss potential changes that can be made to the K-2 playground to align with the family's original vision.
 - Everyone was provided handouts of visual Track and Handicap playground visual by Mary Weber Landscape Architecture along with a cost estimate breakdown.
 - Discussed options for walkway/path. Tie in to Garden Vision committee (teacher led)
 - Need to figure out when we can budget for the vision.
 - As PTO, maybe we can combine general plans with vision.
 - Need to find out where playground pieces went ask Central Office. Don Simpson, construction person that discussed original vision.
 - Check to see if monument is placed in proper area. Probably not move since it's so heavy and was damaged before.

Winter Show:

- Some concern about parking for everyone with 3 different show times. Some thoughts:
 - Can use Chamber, Hall St Church lower lot (after 6:00) Haywood St congregation. Need folks with flashlights to help guide if using Haywood St locale.
 - Send message to carpool?
 - Have staff move cars to Haywood St? Can buses be parked at Middle School, Southern States?
 - Teachers could send out message in weekly notes.
 - Note: this is a school event up to the school to make this safe. Bo will speak with Brad and Ruafika about safety issues/solutions. Bo also sent out email in real time to IDES Safety Committee for awareness and suggestions (thanks!)
- Will have partners providing various activities for kid-centric places to mingle.
 - Great for partners to share outreach messages.
 - Cafeteria will have food (from sponsors also). Kitchen open to cook.
- "Festival" map is going to be handed out to attendees. **ACTION**: Need location sent to Joan.
- Hot Chocolate 10K table to sign folks up to run/volunteer? Need to make sure no one misses their child's show. **Note**: Pepi will already be selling Go Local cards.
- Jennifer Fowler "passing the hat" to collect money for kick starter (Street Beats) during program.

Hot Chocolate 10K Volunteers/Sponsorships:
