

- Mon/Tues, 4/23-24 :: Mosaic Embedding
- Wed/Thurs, 4/25-26 :: Finish Plaster & Aliz Paint
- WED, May 2 :: Oven Firing Celebration
 - 8am Start fire in oven

- Now under review by county. Construction to begin pending engineering review




Isaac Dickson Shade Sail - Visual Simulation
